Evaluating the left upper quadrant (LUQ)

Left upper quadrant (LUQ) view

There are two parts of the LUQ view you want to visualize for free fluid.

Using the phased-array probe in the coronal crosssection, with the indicator towards the patient's head, place the probe in the lower rib spaces and slide down to view both parts of the LUQ view. A positive LUQ view will be seen first at the spleendiaphragm view, and then in the spleen-renal view.
